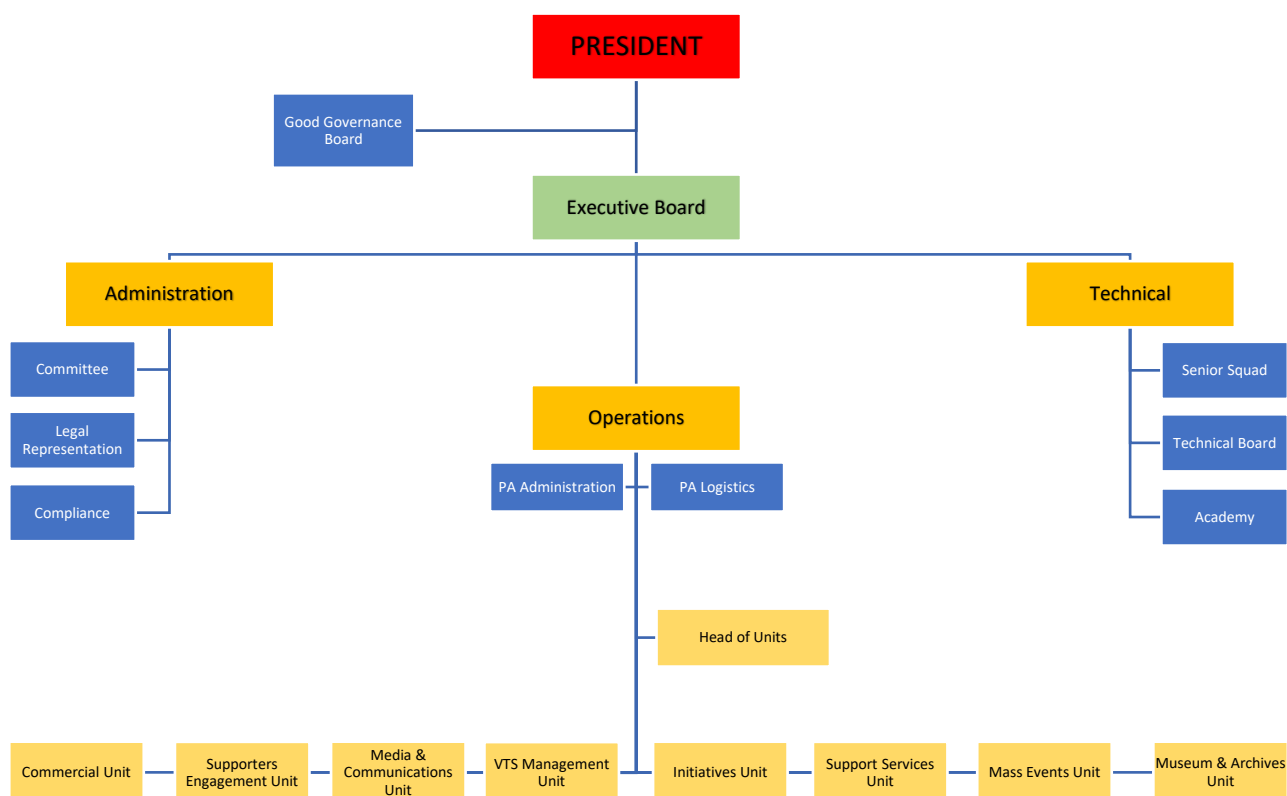
OPERATIONS

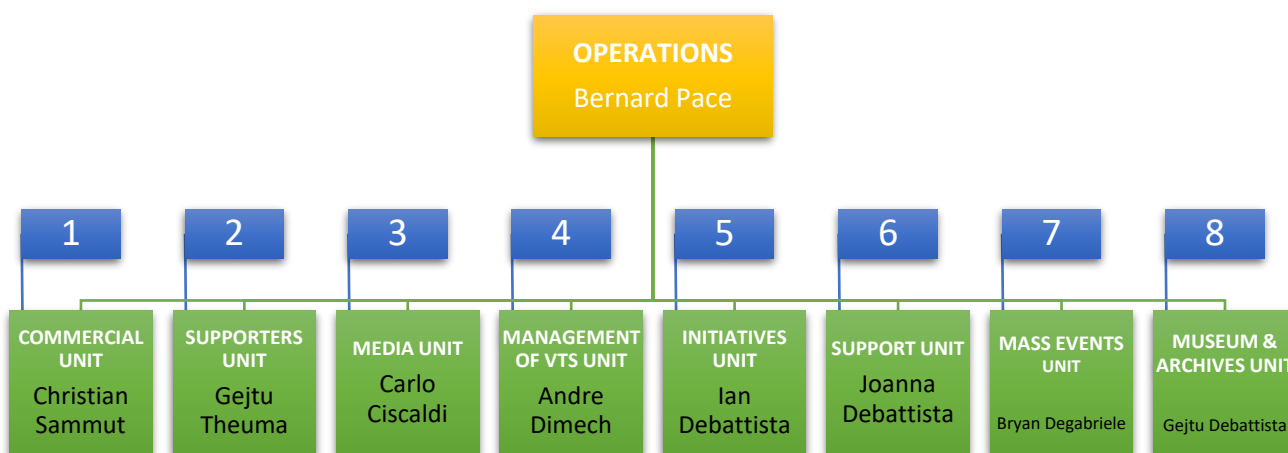
OPERATIONS

Football School of Excellence

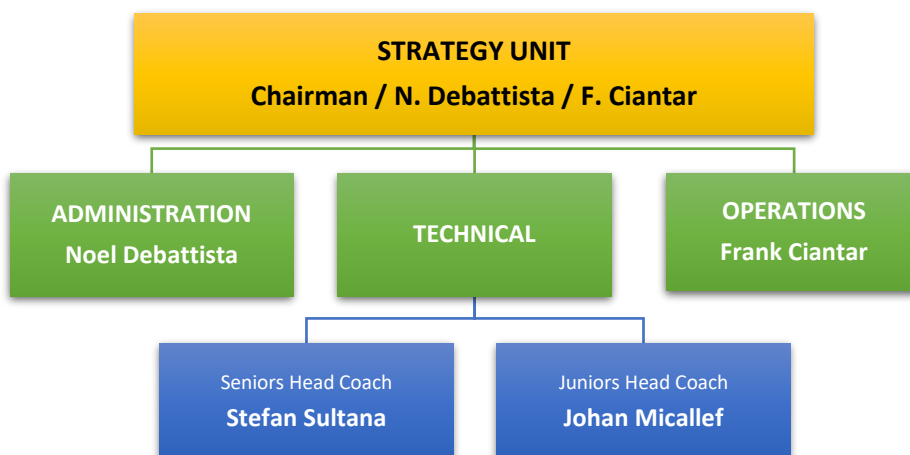

The New Stadium Project

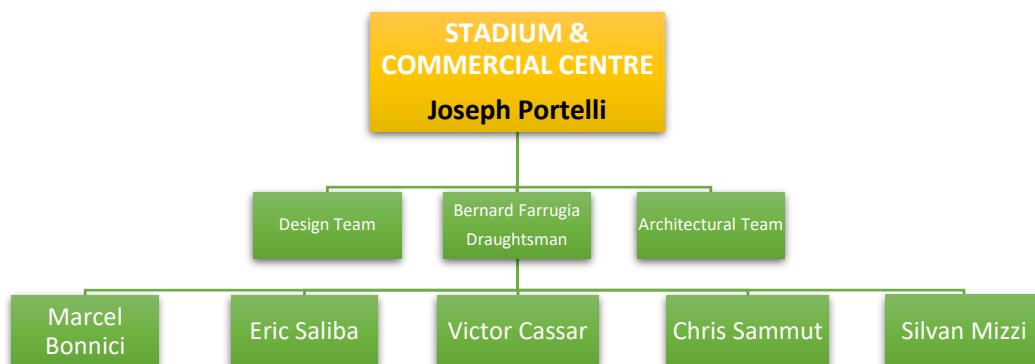

We are currently undergoing several architectural and financial models to determine the type of project that will be selected and eventually submitted to the Planning Authority. As one can imagine, several scenarios are being investigated and discussions are underway with Government Entities regarding this Project. This Project will definitely put the Club on unprecedented levels of Operational and Financial Management, is currently being evaluated to ensure that the correct long-term decisions are taken and the best proposal in terms of Architecture & Aesthetic, Financial Sustainability and Commercial Viability are taken in consideration.

The Project is expected to see the Club moving from an Amateur Short-Term Operational Perspective to Long Term, Sustainable and Professional Management Context. The Stadium Project will include the following Facilities and Amenities:

GOVERNANCE, ETHICS AND DISCIPLINARY BOARD

Preamble

This Board is being set up to monitor the operations of the Hamrun Spartans Football Club. It is completely independent from the Committee and all other Management Structures of the Club and is authorized to regularize its own operations.

Terms of Reference

- To oversee the day-to-day operations of the club and ensure that they are in accordance with the Statute of the Club, the Rules and Regulations of the Malta Football Association, UEFA, FIFA and the Laws of Malta.
- To verify that any transactions, transfers and agreements made by Club officials have been conducted in an orderly, correct, traceable and transparent manner.
- To request any documentation and explanation from the members of the various units of the Club which it deems necessary for its operations.
- To draw up a Disciplinary and Ethics Code for the Club and make sure that all the members and employees of the Club abide by it.
- To hold fair hearings regarding any incidents between its members and/or employees and decide responsibility accordingly.
- To discipline by means of fines, suspension or expulsion any member or employee of the Club who behaves in a manner that causes damage to the Club.
- To regularly review the Statute of the Club and make recommendations regarding amendments which it deems necessary.
- The Secretary's role is to co-ordinate and administer the board and has not voting status
